## Tourism Works for Maryland



- Visitor spending in Maryland rose for the tenth straight year in 2019 to \$18.6 billion.
- Every household would pay \$1,175 more if not for the state and local taxes generated by tourism.
- Maryland's Destination Marketing Organizations leverage the State's \$2.5 million investment in tourism marketing with \$13 million in municipal, county, and private partnership funds.
- 1 of every 16 jobs in Maryland is sustained by tourism activity.



#### **Local Story**

Recently, Hagerstown-Washington County welcomed 566 Athletes from 40 States for the USA Cycling National Championships. Bowman Hospitality opened its fourth hotel - Home2 Suites by Hilton. The Maryland Theatre opened its doors to a beautiful new 30,000 square foot expansion. The C&O Canal National Historical Park launched Canal Boats across the restored aqueduct and broke ground on a new Headquarters scheduled to open in 2021. Visit Hagerstown and the C&O Canal Association were selected host the 2021 World Canal Conference.
